

HEALTH SCIENCE: CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT



The Health Science Certified Nursing Aide program provides instruction on the knowledge and skills necessary for the health care fields. Students must begin in the eleventh grade and seniors must be able to find their own transportation to clinical sites.

Students will learn patient care skills, safety, first aid, CPR, medical terminology, nutrition, anatomy of the body, and knowledge of various diseases. In this two year program, students will gain experience through theory in the classroom and hands-on experience in clinical settings. Course certifications include CPR, first aide, SC Nurses Aide test and NCHSE.
