



# Welding Technology

Welding is a two year course designed to teach students beginning and advanced level welding and cutting skills. In the first year, students will be taught how to use a variety of hand and power tools to perform their duties correctly and safely in the welding shop. The safe use of all tools equipment and processes along with the correct operational procedures will be covered in the classroom before any work is done in the shop.



In the second year, students will learn advanced welding procedures and techniques in all positions, weld symbol and blueprint reading and also be able to take part in the articulation program with Central Carolina Technical College. Upon successful completion of this course the students will get their 10 hour OSHA cards, and NCCER Welding Certifications.

### Average Welder Hourly Wage in South Carolina

Welders earn a median hourly wage of **\$17.64**. Hourly wages typically start from **\$12.63** and go up to **\$26.42**.

### Average Welder Yearly Salary in South Carolina

Welders earn a median salary of **\$36,680** per year. Salaries typically start from **\$26,280** and go up to **\$54,950**.
